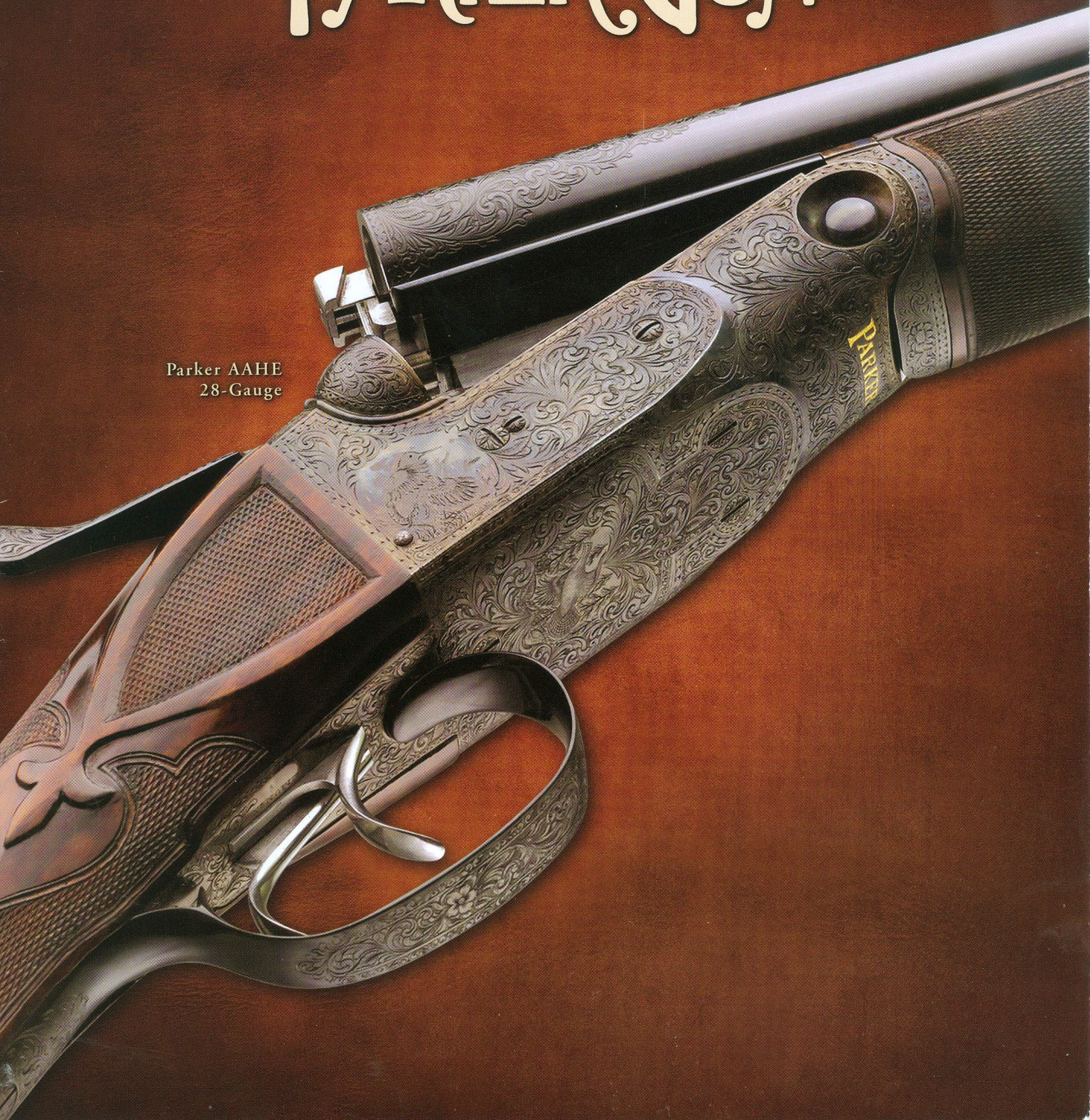


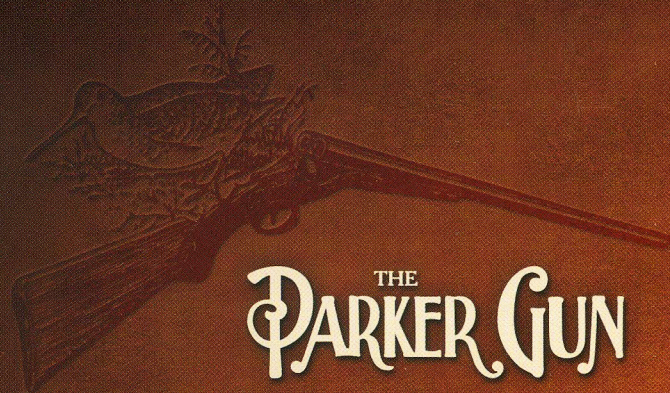

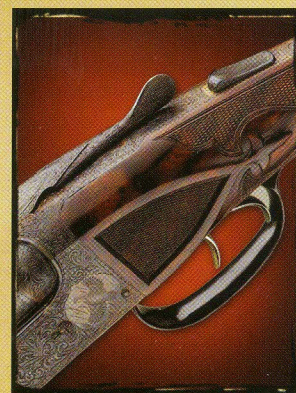
## THE PERPETUATION OF A LEGEND.

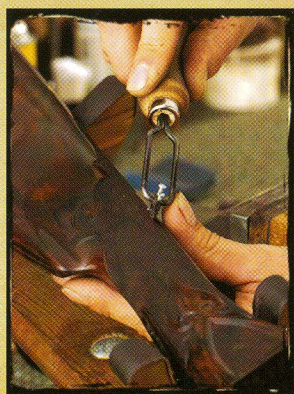

## FORE-END OPTIONS



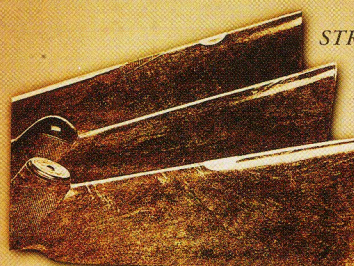
**SPLINTER:** In traditional Parker styling, the streamlined design of the splinter fore-end comes standard.



**BEAVERTAIL:** Also available, the Parker beavertail fore-end offers exceptional control and a firm grip for positive swing and pointing.

(Each fore-end is complete with full coverage checkering and fleur-de-lis outlines fore and aft.)

Specify the grip that suits your shooting style and personalize it with standard engraving. The straight grip and half pistol grip (ball) include gold nameplate in stock belly. The full pistol grip includes gold nameplate in grip or stock.

## ADDITIONAL FEATURES & OPTIONS

**BARREL:** Solid Rib — 26", 28" or 30"

**BORING:** Skeet, IC, Mod or Full

**SIGHTS:** Standard Twin Ivory Beads or Optional Single Ivory Bead

**WOOD:** Standard Exhibition Grade Circassian Walnut or Optional Exhibition Grade American Walnut

**FINISH:** Hand Rubbed Oil

**CHECKERING:** 28 lines per inch Fleur-de-lis

**BUTT:** Skeleton with 28 lines per inch checkering

**STANDARD DIMENSIONS:** 14-1/2 LOP, 1-1/2 DOC, 2-3/8 DAH, 4° Pitch, 0 Cast

**EJECTORS:** Selective Automatic

**SAFETY:** Standard Automatic or Optional Manual

**TRIGGER:** Standard Double or Optional Single Selective — Silver plated and set at 3 to 4 pounds

**ENGRAVING:** All exposed metal on receiver (except hinge pins), trigger guard, top latch and wedge on breech end of barrels. One bead scroll sculpted around the bolsters. Standard engraving to be fine scroll with ruffed grouse on one receiver panel and woodcock on opposite panel (options at customer request). Serial number to be engraved on tang of trigger guard.

**CASE:** Oak and leather case with accessory pockets
